2. The board approved the financial report for the month of March.
3. The board passed the resolution proclaiming May 2-6 as Teacher Appreciation Week
4. The board approved the retirement of Camille Thorne, Teacher, effective May 26, 2016.
5. The board approved the resignation of Greg Shipley, Bus Driver, effective May 27, 2016
6. The board approved the following requests for maternity leave (paid leave will be used until exhausted, then the leave will be unpaid):
