

FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT GOALS

The Board believes that any educational program is influenced greatly by the environment within which it functions. The development of a quality educational program and school facilities which help to implement it must be complementary.

It is this Board's goal to provide the facilities needed for the number of students in the district, to provide the kind of facilities which will best support and accommodate the educational program, and to develop a long-range planning and evaluation program.

The Board recognizes that capital outlay funds are limited and that it must establish priorities in order to make the best use of the school building funds. The Board's first objective will be to develop a plan that eliminates any conditions created by overcrowding. Whenever possible, the cultural as well as educational needs of the community will be considered in planning facilities expansions.

Architects employed by the board will be expected to plan for simplicity of design; sound economics (including low long-range maintenance costs); efficiency in energy consumption; low insurance rates; high educational utility; and flexibility.
