

## SCHOOL DAY

“School day” is defined as the time during a calendar day that a school is open for instruction pursuant to the Board-adopted schedule. It is the responsibility of the Board to establish the beginning and dismissal times at the various grade levels. These hours will satisfy the time requirements established by Ohio law and the State Board of Education regulations.

The administration is authorized to make minor changes in opening and closing times to facilitate the scheduling of transportation; however, any major changes in schedules are subject to Board approval. In any case, the State Board of Education Minimum Standards for length of day must be met or exceeded.
