

INDEPENDENT STUDY

The Board recognizes that students are individuals and that different students will learn best in ways other than the conventional classroom. The Board will expect the Superintendent to make educational options available to students who are judged by District professionals to benefit from exceptions to the usual program of instruction.

The Superintendent will approve such options only when they meet or exceed the criteria established by the State Board of Education Minimum Standards. Only six units of credit can be applied to graduation requirements, and only four can be applied toward the mandatory course requirements.
