

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS

The Board believes that it is essential for parents to be kept fully informed of their children's progress in school. The type of progress reports sent to parents will be devised by the professional staff in cooperation with parents.

Written reports will be provided to parents of children in grades one through 12, 4 times per year. Progress reports will be sent to parents at the completion of each grading period. Regularly scheduled interim reports will also be required for students in danger of failing or whose grade has dropped more than one letter grade from the previous grading period. Conferences with parents will be used as an integral part of the reporting system.
