

## PARENT CONFERENCES

Educators are professionally encouraged and morally obligated to deal with parental questions, concerns, problems and request. Also, much can be learned about the student through parental contracts that would take a great deal of time and effort to learn otherwise. Educators are encouraged to call on parents at their home to review with them their child's progress in the classroom. Again much can be obtained in a visit to the home by going the extra mile to help students. A parental conference should be planned well in advance of the agreed time.

All parent/educator conferences should be for the purpose of enlightening the parents and obtaining information which will enable the educator to make a sound professional decision in the best interest of the student.

Time shall be set aside during the regular school year for elementary parent-teacher conference days.
