

## **Career and Technical Education Methods of Administration**

### **Public Notification of Nondiscrimination in Career and Technical Education Programs**

The Gallipolis City School District offers career and technical education programs in Interactive Media, Industrial Technology, Agricultural Science, and Farm Management. There is not a prerequisite for these classes. We also work collaboratively with Buckeye Hills Career Center to offer other pathways for students. Admission to these programs varies for juniors and seniors however; admission is based on credits, attendance, discipline and, in some cases, end of course exams.
